

## **Growing Business, Rebuilding Neighborhoods**

## **Incentive Descriptions (commercial only)**

<u>Design Assistance</u> This is a no cost grant (paid by CRA) used to provide property owners professional guidance on how to improve the most prominent facades of their building(s) with a maximum grant contribution per application is set at 25% of the annual allocation. The property owner will attend staff assisted consultations with an approved architect. The property owner will receive a conceptual rendering of their building street elevation showing the suggested changes, preliminary colors and possible signage.

<u>Dixieland Art Infusion</u> – A grant program available to all properties/businesses within the priority area (all properties along S. Florida Ave. From E. Magnolia St. to Lenox St.). Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis and grants will be awarded on a first-come first-serve basis.

<u>Facade & Site Improvement –</u> A Matching grant that reimburses 50% of approved improvements to the building's exterior façade, sign(s) and awnings/canopies. Also limited improvements to walls, fencing and landscaping.

**Dixieland** – Up to \$25,000.00

<u>Midtown</u> – Up to \$75,000.00. (60% reimbursement up to \$90,000.00) may be available on a case-by-case basis for implementing results of Design Assistance Grant.

<u>Infill Adaptive Reuse Program</u> – A matching grant that reimburses 50% (Up to \$75,000) for specific leasehold improvements that include the upgrading or installation of new electrical, HVAC, plumbing, sprinkler/fire suppression systems, security systems and ADA compliance items.

<u>Downtown</u> – Up to \$30,000.00 (per project restricted to 2<sup>nd</sup> floors only)

Dixieland - Up to \$25,000.00

Midtown – Up to \$75,000.00

<u>Tax Increment Financing (TIF)</u> — A reimbursement of 50% of the tax increment for 5 years until the end of the term of the agreement for projects with renovations or improvements which are valued at least 50% of the then current assessed value of the property.

<u>Economic Development Infrastructure Incentive Program (STEMM)</u> — A grant that provides up to \$150,000.00 incentive per project on a first-come first-serve basis that supports both new and expanding economic development projects that advance science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM). Assistance provided to qualified projects through electric, water/wastewater, utility extensions and relocations, transportation infrastructure development and/or utility impact fee reimbursements.

<u>Encouraging Development Growth & Expansion (EDGE)</u> - A matching grant up to \$25,000.00 per project on a first-come first-serve basis that supports the development of new and expanding science, technology, engineering & mathematics (STEM), manufacturing and food service-related businesses.
